More than 250 people attended the traditional culinary fest in Lyaskovets. The event took place near the Lyaskovets Monastery on 6-8th of May 2022. The participants from Kozarevets and Lyaskovets prepared the traditional dishes *banitza* and *patatnik*. The Culinary fest was part of the Xth National Festival of the Sheep Breeders in Bulgaria. The event is focused on the traditional Bulgarian livelihood – sheep breeding and the traditional Bulgarian culture and folklore. Near the Monastery of St. Peter and St Paul, the visitors had the chance to see sheep breeds, farmers competitions, museum exhibitions and culinary demonstrations.
